Photographer Duncan Giblin will be hosting his latest exhibition at the Goulburn street gallery in Hobart.

Artists Statement

“The exhibition titled *Icarus* . Is an extension of my previous works examining the movement of birds and the Tasmanian coastline this collection features many new works that follow and expand the meditative and contemplative style of my previous images, but with a focus on exploring the fringes of usable light.

I have been searching for my own photographic signature based on how I feel when I see things; I want my work to convey that feeling. As a consequence I have pushed the limits of lighting to portray the atmosphere and mood I find most interesting.

Transversely I have for this series of works explored shooting directly into the sun and push exposure, finding that like Icarus there is very fine line between complete failure of the image and something unique and beautiful.

The exhibition images were taken in locations ranging from Flinders Island through to the South East of Tasmania.

I travel to remote places but also look for the resistance if you like, pockets of wild beauty and native birds still found in the cities and suburbs”.
